1 **Page 1** - By the Permission of God I **William VICKERMAN** of
2 **Kidroyd** in the parish of Almondbury in the county of
3 York clothier being of sound disposing mind memory
4 and understanding do this thirteenth day of February in the
5 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
6 make and publish my last will and testament in manner
7 following (that is to say) First I will order and direct that
8 all my just Debts Funeral expenses and the Charges
9 attending the probate and execution of this my Will shall
10 be paid and satisfied by my executors hereinafter named
11 out of my Estate and Effects. I give and bequeath to **my 2**
12 **sons John and Thomas VICKERMAN** all my tenant rights and interest
13 of and in the Messuage, outbuildings? Dyehouse land and tenements which I have
14 **Page 2** - under **Sir John RAMSDEN Baronet** at **Kidroyd** aforesaid to hold
15 to them their Executors Administrators and assigns as tenants in
16 common and I humbly hope that my said landlord will permit
17 them to occupy the same pursuant to the aforesaid bequest. I give and
18 bequeath to my said two **sons John and Thomas VICKERMAN** all my
19 household furniture looms jennies? dyepans and utensils and
20 implements of Trade and Husbandry Stock and cattle and farming
21 stock and tenters which may be in upon or about my said premises
22 at the time of my death in equal shares and proportions And I
23 do hereby will order and direct that my said Executors shall work
24 up and manufacture the wool which I have on hand into such
25 marketable goods as they shall think fit and shall and will sell and
26 dispose of the same Goods together with all the woollen cards? and other Goods which
I have manufactured and ready for sale, in such manner and at such
27 reasonable time after my death as they in their discretion shall
28 think proper for the most money and best price which can be
29 obtained for the same. And the monies arising from the sale of
30 such goods and also all the rest residue and remainder of my estate
31 **Page 3** - and effects (except the herein bequeathed bed whatsoever and

32 wheresoever and of what nature or kind soever the same maybe a
33 [xxx] or in whose hands custody or power the same be. I
34 give and bequeath to my said [two sons John and Thomas and](#)
35 [my daughter Hannah the wife of John WILLIAMSON](#) in equal
36 share and proportions and to be paid and divided amongst them
37 and their respective lawful representative at the expiration of
38 (subject to the payment of my just debts funeral expenses and the charges of the
39 twelve months next after my death I give to [my said daughter](#)
40 [Hannah](#) the camp bedstead and bedding standing in the parlour
41 to be delivered to her upon my death. I do hereby appoint my
42 friend [Matthew LODGE](#) of Bankend farmer and [my said son](#)
43 [John](#) joint executors of this my will and do hereby revoke
44 all former wills by me made in witness whereof I the
45 [Page 4 - said William VICKERMAN](#) the testator have to this my last
46 will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year
47 first above written.
