1 Page 1 - THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of
2 me William VICKERMAN of Mold Green in the township of
3 Dalton in the County of York, Inn Keeper. My will and mind is that all
4 my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses be paid out of my estate
5 and effects. I give unto my dear wife Mary Jane all my household
6 furniture, books, pictures china, glass and all my household utensils and
7 effects whatsoever for her own use and benefit' I give and devise unto
8 my sons Dodson VICKERMAN and Tom Bailey VICKERMAN all my freehold
9 estate situate in Moldgreen aforesaid now occupied by myself and others
10 and all my leasehold premises situate at Kidroyd in the township of
11 Almondbury upon trust to allow my said wife to occupy the house and premises
12 I now occupy and to received the rents and income arising out of all
13 my said freehold and leasehold estates during the term of her natural
14 life and after her death to sell the said freehold and leasehold estates by
15 public auction or by private contract as they may think best and to
16 divide the proceeds coming from such sale among and between my
17 four sons and my daughter Alice equally share and share alike and
18 should any of my said children die without issue before the gifts herein
19 given to them become due then in that case I request that the share of
20 him her or them dying shall be divided equally among the survivors
21 of them my said children and I also order that the gifts herein given to
22 any female shall be for her own and separate use'. And lastly I appoint my
23 said wife Executrix and my said sons Dodson and Tom Bailey Trustees
24 and Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof
25 I have hereunto set my hand this second day of December in the year of
26 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two.

28 Signed by the said William VICKERMAN the Testator as and for his last Will
29 and Testament in the presence of us present at the same time who at
30 his request in his presence and in the presence or each other have herewith
31 set our names as witness hereto and which said Will has the words 'County
32 of York' in line fourteen page one obliterated.
